Master Coaches Clinic: Facilitating Instruction for RtI/Classroom Coaches

To improve instructional deliveries, the role of the coach is critical. Many site-based coaches have found their responsibilities expanded to include **multiple subject areas**—reading, math, writing, content-area learning—as well as facilitation of RtI. The Master Coaches Clinic hones coaches' skills to address **principles of RtI**, including **effective instruction**, **use of data** to improve instructional focus, activation of learning through vigorous and rigorous **instructional delivery**, adjustment of lesson objectives to ensure **standards-based instruction**, and **monitoring of student progress** to ensure an accelerated rate of learning.

- Coaching strategies;
- Diplomatically helping teachers improve instructional delivery;
- Coaching on subjects outside of their expertise;
